SCHOOL CELLPHONE POLICY – 2016

The school acknowledges that cellphones have become an important and useful means of communication. However, it is also aware of the fact that the use and abuse of cellphones, particularly by children, pose social, ethical and safety consequences e.g. learners have been held up at knife-point for their cellphones just outside the school premises.

Cellphones are, therefore, not permitted at school.

Cellphones, once confiscated, will be returned as follows:

First time offenders: Cellphones will be returned when a fine of R250 is paid within 5 school days of confiscation.

Repeat offenders: Cellphones will be returned when a fine of R500 is paid within 5 school days of confiscation

NOTE:

- This amended policy will be implemented as at 5 April 2016.
- Cellphones that are not collected within 5 school days **will not be returned** thereafter.
- The school will NOT take responsibility for the theft or loss of any cellphone brought to school, no matter what the circumstances.
- The school will not, under any circumstances, engage parents in discussions relating to cellphone confiscations.
