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## DRESS CODE OF THE SCHOOL : 2025

1	Centenary school dress (A-line) with collar, long or short sleeves. This has to be on/below knee. Learners will be allowed to wear the Centenary pants on condition that the bottom is unaltered and the dress remains on/below the knee.	White school shirt. School grey long pants. ONLY 14 to 16-inch bottom will be allowed. No Collies / Dickies etc.
2	White school ankle socks, NO secret socks will be allowed, black opaque stockings allowed, no patterns, no sheer.	Grey (plain) / Black (plain) socks, NO secret socks will be allowed.
3	Black school shoes.	Black school shoes.
4	Centenary school scarf (optional): Available at Al-Shazia Stores, plain navy blue scarf.	Plain black belts (no studs or fancy buckles). Centenary Secondary School Tie.
5	Navy blue jersey or navy blue blazer.	Navy blue jersey or navy blue blazer.
6	<p><b>Hair:</b> shoulder length. If longer, hair must be in a SINGLE plait held in position with navy blue or white hair aids.</p> <p><i>No fancy and/or colour hair clips (plain black only).</i></p> <p><b>No hair styling agent/gel/hairspray.</b> <b>No tints, bleaching and streaking.</b> <b>A medium size bun at the back of the head. The following braids and extensions will be allowed:</b> <b>Straight back, straight up, snoopy with extension, ultra and braids with black wool.</b> <b>NOTE: ALL BRAIDS AND EXTENSIONS MUST BE TIED, BRAIDS MUST NOT BE THICKER THAN THE 'PINKY FINGER'.</b></p>	<p><b>Hair:</b> Schoolboy haircut. Two length neatly blended; short sideburns, no hairstyling agent/<b>gel/hairspray</b> <b>No tints, bleaching and streaking of hair.</b> No beards –boys must be clean-shaven. No modified eyebrows. <b>NOTE: NO BRAIDS AND EXTENSIONS ARE ALLOWED</b></p>
