Two length neatly blended; short side- burns, no hairstyling agent/gel/hairspray No tints, bleaching and streaking of hair. No beards –boys must be clean- shaven. No modified eyebrows. NOTE: NO BRAIDS AND EXTENSIONS ARE ALLOWED
